

Local Anesthesia & Nitrous Analgesia

I understand and consent for using local anesthesia & nitrous analgesia for treatment.

I have been informed and understand that occasionally there are some complication with local anesthesia & nitrous analgesia interacting with other medications. These include the following and others:

- Allergic reaction, hives, shortness of breath
- Fainting, dizziness, rapid heart rate, headaches, vomiting, nausea etc.
- Hematoma (internal and/or external bruise)
- Soreness at injection site
- Bite tongue, lip and cheek due to numbness
- Paresthesia (temporary or permanent numbness of lip or tongue)
- Broken needle
- Swelling and bruising

Anesthetics, medications, and prescriptions may cause drowsiness and lack of coordination, which can be increased by the use of alcohol or other drugs/medications. I have been advised to refrain from operating any vehicle or hazardous device until fully recovered from the effect of the anesthetic or medications that may have been given to me for the dental care.

I acknowledge the receipt of and understand post operative instructions and will arrange for a postoperative visit if necessary. It has been explained to me and I understand there is no warranty or guarantee as to any results and/or use. I understand I may ask for a full recital of all possible risk attendants to phrases of any care by just asking.
